Upgrading of Rear Kitchen and Toilet Areas

What is proposed?

- Replacement of the flat roof structure to improve insulation.
- Larger roof lights to provide more natural light and a more open feel.
- Full refit of the kitchen with new units, fitted fridge, dishwasher and cooker.
- Merging of the two small toilet areas to create one family-friendly unisex toilet.
- Retention and updating of the disabled toilet facility.
- · Improved air extraction, heating and lighting.
- Extensive tiling and full re-decoration.
- Replacement windows, rear of hall.



When will this be happening?

Summer 2018, to align as far as possible with the school summer holidays^A. During the works, the rear kitchen & toilets will be closed and there will be limited

access to a reduced size hall. We will support regular users where possible.
